ORDER


UPON CONSIDERATION of Receiver for Liberty Trade International, Inc. and David M. Robinson, Raymond J. Peroutka, Jr.'s Response to Charles J. Ware's Motion for Withdrawal of Appearance, it is this 27th day of July 2006 ORDERED that:

- i. Robinson will receive written notice of all filings and proceedings in accordance with the Maryland Rules at his last known address;
- ii. Robinson will promptly and timely notify the Receiver and the Plaintiff of any changes in address;
- iii. Upon receiving notice, Robinson, within the time allotted by the Maryland Rules, may set forth for the Court, in writing, his position regarding the relevant pleading or proceeding;
- iv. Additionally, within the time allotted by the applicable Maryland Rules, Robinson may request, in writing, that he be present at any relevant proceeding;

v. Should Robinson not file a response within the time allotted by the Maryland Rules, it is understood that Robinson does not object to the relevant filing or proceeding; and

vi. As Robinson will have been afforded the opportunity to be heard in accordance with the Maryland Rules, Robinson's procedural due process rights will have been satisfied and the Court will issue its ruling without any further proceedings.
