ORDER FINDING DAVID M. ROBINSON IN CONTEMPT

Upon consideration of the Order to Show Cause entered on March 30, 2006, and upon consideration of the evidence and arguments submitted with the Order to Show Cause and presented in court, the Court grants the Commissioner's request that David M. Robinson ("Robinson") be found in contempt. The Court being advised of the basis of the Commissioner's request and good cause for granting the request shown, the Court finds that this Order is necessary to prevent the risk of further loss of investor funds, to protect the public interest and to avoid the harm that will result from a continuing violation of the Court's orders.

THEREFORE, it is this 30 day of April, 2006, at 10:55 Am. m. hereby, ORDERED:

1. That the Commissioner's request be and hereby is granted.
2. That Robinson turn over to the Receiver within 24 hours of the Court's order all the books, records and computers relating to Liberty Trade International, Inc. ("LTI"), including Robinson's personal computers.
3. That Robinson give the Receiver ^{immediately} ~~within two hours of the~~ Court's order, access to

LTI's place of business in the home of Carmelita Hackett at 7208 Bogley Road, Apt. 202, Windsor Mill, MD 21244, for the purpose of retrieving all assets and records belonging to or purchased with LTI funds.

4. That Robinson turn over to the Receiver ^{by 5 PM April 4, 2006} ~~within 24 hours of the Court's order~~ all goods and assets purchased with LTI funds, wherever located, including but not limited to all cars, furniture, furnishings, pictures and collectibles, and jewelry.

5. That Robinson turn over to the Receiver immediately all funds held in any bank account for Robinson and for LTI.

6. That Robinson supplement within two hours of the issuance of this Order the sworn accounting dated March 30, 2006, to provide supporting detail and setting forth the identity and location of all Liberty Trade International, Inc. and personal assets and liabilities and the identity and location of all goods, services and assets purchased with Liberty Trade International, Inc. funds for his benefit or the benefit of his friends and family.
